MISSION STATEMENT

To promote coaching as a profession and to raise the standard of coaching throughout Ulster to ensure progressive development at all levels of swimming.

The Ulster Coaches Association will come under the umbrella of the Ulster Region Swim Ireland and shall be subject to its rules

The UCA will be an integral part of Coaching Northern Ireland.

The association shall have its own Constitution and Rules and any changes shall be presented to the URSI for ratification.

CONSTITUTION

- 1. The constitution shall be known as the Coaches Association of the Ulster Region of Swim Ireland and shall be known hereafter as “the Association” or “the Coaches Association”**
- 2. The aims of the association shall be to promote interest in and raise the standard of coaching in the Province.**
- 3. The Association will have 2 tiers – an associate member and a full member. An associate member can be any person interested in the sport and it is not essential to hold any qualifications. A full member shall hold a minimum of teachers award and be actively working with a competitive squad in an affiliated club.**
- 4. All members of the association must be members of Swim Ireland**
- 5. All members shall pay the agreed annual membership fee.**
- 6. The coaches association shall control all matters related to coaching.**
- 7. The committee, which shall be elected by all full members of the association, shall consist of a President, Chairperson, Honorary Secretary, Honorary Treasurer and a minimum of 4 members, of which 1 only shall be an associate member and the remainder full members**
- 8. UCA shall decide the membership fee.**
- 9. The committee shall control the financial affairs.**
- 10. The annual audit shall be presented to URSI.**
- 11. The UCA have the right to rescind membership to anyone bringing the UCA into disrepute.**
- 12. A quorum shall consist of a minimum of 5 members.**
